

TRAVEL BY TRAIN

We recommend travelling in air-conditioned first or second class for both day and overnight journeys, and in "Executive Chair Car" on a Shatabdi Express, which operate on a number of routes. When planning to visit Darjeeling, Shimla or Ooty you may take one of the famous "Toy Trains". There are also luxurious "Travelling Palace" trains. (See pages 48 & 49)
